Requirements for Total Dog Award To be eligible for this award, a dog must meet the requirements listed below. 1) Compete in conformation with competition and win one of the following classes:

- a. Best Male/Female of Variety
- b. Best Male/Female
- c. Best of Winners
- d. Champion
- e. Grand Champion
- f. Best of Breed
- 2) Earn a PASS or higher in the FDEBGDC Liberated Field Trial on Saturday, November 13th, 2021 or Sunday, November 14th, 2021.

Show Hours: Judging will begin at 2:00 PM on Saturday November 13th, 2021.

Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Mailed entries must be received by November 10th 2021 to qualify for pre-entry fee. Day of Show Entries will be accepted between the hours of 12:30 PM and 1:30pm

. No Day of Show Entries will be accepted without a valid UKC Registration or Temporary Listing Number.

Notice to Exhibitors

- 1) All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
- 2) Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC licensed event.
- 3) UKC, FDEBGDC, their agents, and employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children no under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC/FDEBGDC are not responsible for loss, accidents, or thefts.

- 4) Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs no required for further judging will be excused.
- 5) No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such.
- 6) Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
- 7) UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
- 8) UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
- 9) Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or unzippered crate.

General Information

- 1) Show grounds will be open to exhibitors at 12:30 PM. Overnight security is not provided and no dogs may be left on the grounds overnight. All times are Central Standard Time.
- 2) No smoking in all building and areas designated as such.
- 3) No admission or parking fees.

Entry Eligibility

- Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC as Epagneul Bretons, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
- 2) An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

Submitting Entries

- 1) Entries may be submitted on the Official UKC Entry Form included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC Entry Form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of these forms may be used as well.
- 2) Advance entries may be mailed, emailed, or hand-delivered to the Show Secretary.
- 3) Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.
- 4) Advance entries must be received by the closing date and time: 7 PM on November 10th, 2020.

Payment

- 1) Payment may be made by cash, check, Venmo, or money order. No entry will be accepted without payment.
- 2) Make checks and money orders payable to FDEBGDC. Checks and money orders must be payable in US funds. Cash will be in US currency.

3) Post-dated checks or returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. FDEBGDC will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Refunds

- 1) No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Advance Entry deadline.
- 2) Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
- If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of the entry will be made.
- 4) Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
- 5) If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, tornadoes, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

Entry Confirmation

Written confirmation of entries will be made by mail, email, or text as soon as practicable after receipt of Advanced Entries. If you do not receive confirmation by the Friday preceding this event, please notify the Show Secretary, Kaleb Miller at <u>vobbretons@gmail.com</u> or 712-363-5454. Receipt of email entries will be acknowledged immediately by return email but this does not constitute confirmation of the entry. Entry will be confirmed upon receipt of the appropriate entry fees.

Class Change/Correction of Entry

- 1) Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.
- 2) Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.
- 3) All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.

Armbands

One armband will be assigned to each entered dog for all shows and trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. Armbands can be picked up from the Show Secretary on the day of the show. If you lose your armband or it gets destroyed you can see the Show Secretary for a replacement.
